<b>Year Group</b>	<b>Date</b>	<b>Visit</b>	<b>Aim of Visit</b>
Reception	27/2/18 28/6/18	Pizza Express  The Look Out	In Spring 1 reception class will be looking at 'The World Around Us' for our topic. They will be finding out about different countries around the world, their language, culture etc. They will be finding out about Italy and the origins of pizza at pizza express before making their own pizza. This will tie in with all areas covering 'Understanding the World.' The children will take part in a relevant workshop that a class topic will be based around
Year 1	21/5/18	Windsor Castle	To tie in with our topic of 'Castles', Year 1 children will be visiting Windsor Castle and learning about its history from its Norman beginnings to the present day.
Year 2	June 2018 – Exact date to be confirmed	Pitt Rivers Museum, Oxford	This is a Science based trip which will focus on materials, the topic of the Summer Term. The children will be given an introductory talk within the museum which will be followed by a practical workshop on materials.
Year 3 both classes	5/12/17	The Making of Harry Potter Warner Brothers Studio	This trip ties in with what we are learning in both English and DT. In Autumn 2, Year 3 are looking at play scripts in English, where they will write their own play script. We are also looking at how sets are designed and planning our own in DT/Art show box set design which they will act their play scripts out in. This trip help the children to understand the concept of writing for performance and how this then transfers to actually



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			performing their written work. Mrs Ahmed and Miss Koza will develop a lesson to support their learning starting at the tour then finishing off back at school the next day.
Year 4	19/3/18	Ufton Court	Year 4 will have Saxon themed trip to Ufton court and will learn about the following: to know about crafts and beliefs of the Saxon people, appreciate that accounts and opinions about past events may vary, make comparisons between the present and the lives of people in the past and to learn about key events in History - the Battle of Reading.
Year 5	21/3/18	Hampton Court	Year 5 will visit Hampton Court Palace to explore the social history of the Tudor period. The children will tour the palace and take part in workshops focussing on Tudor navigation and the kitchens of Henry VIII. Weather permitting, the children will have the opportunity to sketch Base Court and the formal gardens.
Year 6	22/5/18 Date to be confirmed	Hurley Outdoor Education Canoeing and Kayaking	RBWM's Outdoor Education Project's base on Hurley Island houses all the necessary facilities to ensure a fun activity day on the river for our Year 3 pupils.  Canoeing in pairs or small groups develops communication and teamwork skills, trust and confidence. The exercises take place in a very sheltered area of the river where the children learn



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Year 6	20/06/18 – 22/6/18	PGL Liddington	<p>how to steer a boat, and then paddle round the small nearby islands. The group will also learn more about the river and its wildlife on their journey around the island.</p> <p>After a picnic-style lunch, the children will take part in kayaking and develop their balance and coordination, perseverance, trust, teamwork and a range of other skills.</p> <p>Activity centre resort, staying for two nights. 3-6 people per ensuite room.
